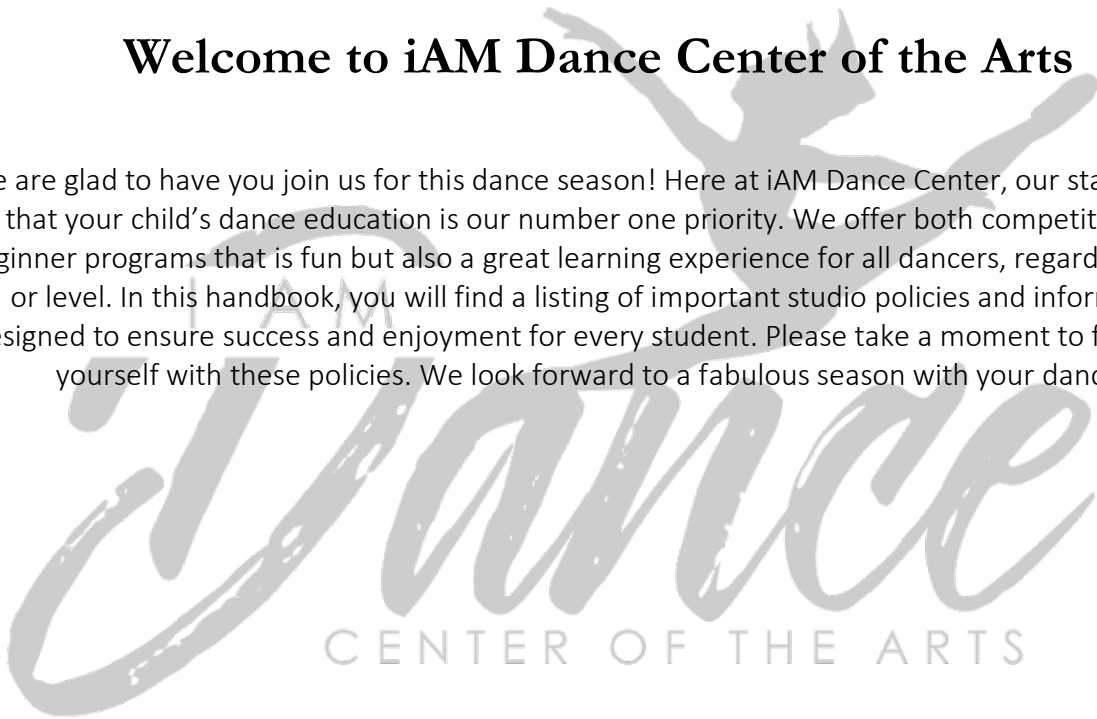

Our Mission:

Our mission is to serve as positive pioneers in our community instilling value and discipline in our youth. We seek to pave the way for many talented youths in their efforts to fulfill their dreams and talents to their greatest abilities.

Your Commitment:

Dance is a long-term commitment. By enrolling for classes, you are committing to holding a space on that roster for a duration of 6 months **minimum**. If a dancer quits after being placed on a roster/class there will be a \$100 withdrawal fee, plus all money paid towards monthly dues, competitions and uniforms will be forfeited. Exit dates (without penalty) is **December 9, 2023 & June 8, 2024**. Exiting during any other time of the year **will** result in the withdrawal fee along with any current fees owed on the account at the time of departure. Please understand dance is a TEAM sport. If one student quits "part" way through the year it affects the entire team/class. Dancers must attend all practices, performances, and competitions!!

Plan on all competition and performance *seeking* students practicing 2-3 hours per day, 2-4 times a week including a technique definition class. Beginner students can expect to practice 60 minutes, 2 times per week. All other extracurricular classes: 60 minutes, 1 time per week.

Class Routine:

All dancers are **required** to wear assigned practice gear to every class. No exception. Please do not drop your child off if they do not have their proper attire. Dancers will be turned around at the door for not adhering to this policy and a parent/guardian must come back to pick them up.

During class: all jewelry must be removed! **Gum is not allowed**. Hair must be pulled back. Shoes may/may not mandatory.

Cell phones, watches, earbuds, etc. are **not** allowed during practices! If there is an emergency, please call the office phone (803-804-6062). Filming parts of the routine during practice is **not** allowed **unless** you have prior approval from an instructor or the director.

Parents, friends, and family members **are not** allowed in the studio. All family members and friends must remain in the foyer/waiting area! ~UPDATE~ Due to covid-19, our lobby/sitting area is limited to any persons other than dancers entering/exiting the studio.

Studio Etiquette

- No phones inside either studio, during class (leave inside your assigned lockers)
- No in/out of the classroom for any reason. Use the restroom prior to class and/or during breaks
- No leaning on the barre, No leaning on the mirror, No leaning on the center pole
- When not learning, students should be at attention.
- Raise hand to speak.
- Walk around perimeters and not in front of staff or student when entering/exiting placement on the floor
- Moving for superiors
- No food or drink outside of their breakroom (No sunflower seeds at all!!!!)
- The breakroom is to always remain clean. The only item permitted atop the desk are dance bags with all materials **INSIDE** bag or **locker**.
- When sitting: Sit around U shape under the barres only. (not against the mirror)
- Expected to be at attention outside the door no earlier or later than 2 minutes before class.

- We will only allow them to enter when they're quiet & at attention.
- For tardy students:
 - Stretch in the lobby.
 - For every minute they are late, they accumulate a set of disciplinary consequences.
 - Students enrolled in classes that choose not to be on time or enter at all must go home.
- Bathroom before/after class only
- Breaks: give a break every 45 minutes (5 minutes)
- No break for 1-hour classes
- No bullying
- No horseplaying

Sportsmanship:

All dancers and parents representing iAM Dance Center are always expected to behave in a **respectful** manner. Parents **must** refrain from speaking negatively about other dancers, parents, or instructors. All dancers must treat their teammates, instructors, and other dancers' part of other teams in a kind and courteous manner. Any disrespectful treatment (bullying, name calling, cursing, talking badly about another, etc...) to any other parent, dancer or instructor can result in parent's access to entering the studio being revoked or student's removal from the studio.

Attendance & Absences:

Attendance

Every practice is **required**. Attendance is crucial to the team/class. If one student is missing, the whole team and/or class is affected and possibly cannot practice! Please submit vacation or expected absences, in writing to our lead instructor, Ms. A'Vionne.

Absences

To avoid removal from dance pieces, if sickness requires absence from more than one practice a doctor's note is required!

Tardiness

Please do NOT be late for practice!! **Please be sure to pick up your child on time. There will be a \$5.00 late pick up fee after the 2nd offense of late pickup.**

Class Registration & Tuition

Registration:

To register for and view available/open classes, please fill out the registration form online (www.dancestudio-pro.com/online/iamdancecenter) and include registration fee.

Registration Fee: \$25 (first child), \$15 (second child), \$10 (third child)

Dropped Classes:

Dance instruction follows a season calendar year and it is expected that dancers complete the entire season. Should you decide it is necessary to drop a class you must notify the office **IN WRITING (NO EXCEPTIONS)**. Simply discontinuing attendance **DOES NOT** constitute a dropped class – you will still be responsible for your regular monthly tuition amount until proper written notice is received.

Tuition is a **SEMESTER FEE** that is broken into **MONTHLY/WEEKLY INSTALLMENTS** *for your convenience*. Our schedule and tuition amounts **allow for up to two cancelled** classes outside of our regular calendar without a make-up class being scheduled. **All tuition and fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.**

You must pay in full for any month you attend even ONE CLASS for that month. **NO PRO-RATING AND NO REFUNDS ON ANY PRE-PAID FEES.**

Note: iAM Dance Center of the Arts reserves the right to discontinue service to any student. However, we do not discriminate based on gender, race, religion, or otherwise.

Tuition Due Date: All tuition is posted to your online accounts on the 1st of each month (**late fees apply after 4 days delinquent**). **Payment reminder emails are automatically sent out on the 4th of each month.** Tuition is due either weekly (every Monday), bi-weekly (every other Monday), on a set date every month or on the 1st of each month. Any agreement for payment that is past the 4th of the month **does not** have a grace period. After this time, a late fee of \$15 will be automatically added to your account and must be paid. All students **must** have an auto-bill form on file at the time of registration. Cash, checks, and money orders are accepted **on** the due date. The auto-bill form will only be used after the due date has passed and no payment has been received. See Auto Draft/Credit Form.

- ****NEW**** Tuition fees are due on the 1st of each month. Tuition accounts will be allowed a 14- day grace period before students will no longer be allowed to attend class(es). Late fee policy still applies.

This also applies to any uniform/costume/competition fee due dates.

Vacations:

During the months of June and July attendance is optional. Attendance is mandatory starting in August to be considered for competitions, performances & recitals during the season. We will not have classes during holidays or spring break.

If any practice is missed in the week leading up to a performance, an alternate dancer may be used at the instructor's discretion!

For extended vacations or vacations that you expect to not be charged tuition, you must give the instructors 2 weeks' notice!

Competition Team Tryouts:

iAM Dance Center, currently, only competes in the style of majorette with the Red Rose Mafia Majorette Dance Team. Tryouts are held twice a year: summer bootcamp in July & mid-season bootcamp in December.

Competitions & Performances:

(Our goal is to compete 1-2 times per month.)

All competitions and performances are mandatory! If a competition or performance is missed, it hurts the entire team! If any practice is missed in the week leading up to a competition or performance, an alternate student may be brought in at the instructors' discretion for practices and competition/performance. You will still be responsible for the competition and practice fees. For Elite Members: Not showing up for a competition may result in termination of the team. All dancers are required to be at competitions early for warm-up. It is imperative for all the dancers to warm up their routine exactly as it will be completed prior to competitions. The instructors will tell you the exact time to arrive at competition. If a dancer is late for warm-up or does not show up for warm-up, an alternate may be used at the instructors' discretion. Uniforms must be worn in full during the entire competition. Warm up pants and jackets may be worn upon arrival and after the squad has finished competing. Hair and makeup must be done according to the way the instructors have decided. **All piercings (ex: earrings, nose rings, belly rings, etc.) must be removed and tattoos covered prior to arrival at competitions.**

Student Selection: There are many factors that go into student selection for performances and competitions. Here are a few factors: attendance, extra rehearsals attended or scheduled privates, performance value, musicality with movement, uniformity (does he/she compliment the dancers as a whole), technique, retainment of choreography & corrections, and visibility; these are the main factors.

Class Attire & Uniforms:

Class attire is required to be purchased at registration and must be worn during each class. No exception. **Students will not be allowed to participate in class if he/she is not in proper hair and attire dressings.**

Competition Uniforms are as followed:

All uniforms for creative dances, field shows, and special performances **must be returned** at the end of the season. Fees paid for uniforms are for the rental of uniforms throughout the season.

All uniform pieces are required to be purchased or rented unless noted or told otherwise by your instructor. If you lose, rip, or stain a part of your uniform, let your instructor know as soon as possible! You will be responsible for the cost to replace that piece of your uniform! Instructors will let you know what needs to be purchased. *There may be additional accessories needed to purchase per competition, performance and/or recital.*

Recital Uniforms are as followed:

All uniforms for showcases & recitals are for students to keep.

Fees:

There is a lot that goes into dance. We have custom uniforms created just for our teams and our events. There is also custom music and choreography created for each class, each semester! In competitive dance each dancer on the team needs to look exactly alike on the team so the team looks like a whole. Therefore, each dancer must have the exact same hair, uniform, bow, shoes, socks, and makeup!

Fees are broken up as followed:

Registration: due at time of enrollment; once a year - \$25.00 1st student, \$15.00 2nd student, \$10.00 3rd & +, \$35.00 re-enrollment

1 hour / week: \$15.00 per week

2 hours / week: \$19.00 per week

3 hours/ week: \$26.00 per week

7 hours/ week: \$40.00 per week

8 hours/ week: \$44.00 per week

9 hours/week: \$48.00 per week

10 hours/week: \$52.00 per week

11 - 12 hours/week: \$56.00 per week

13 hours/week: \$60.00 per week (\$4.00 increase per hour)

(Tuition covers facility cost, instructor fees (in house & guest), equipment, class materials, etc.)

Late Fees: \$15.00 applied on day 4 of being late (Suspension occurs on day 15 of being late)

Auto draft occurs on day 3 to avoid late fees. Inability to process will result in late fee on day 4.

Drop-in class tuition: \$20 per class

Recital Fee & Performance Uniforms: \$125-250/ year (includes facility cost, props, staff, choreography and music, in addition to, all undergarments, headpieces, shoes & **the rental** of costumes per semester) (due in April of each season)

Competitions/Uniforms (rental)/Choreography/music/etc: varies per season

(**Spring Season:** January – May, **Fall Season:** August – December)

****New Installment plan will be available this season for competitive dancers due to launching of RRM****

Private Lessons: \$40 for 1 hour session, \$70 for 2 hour session

Group Private Lessons: 3 students for \$20 per hour, 2 students for \$25 per hour

**5-10% additional discount for Parent Committee members

_____ Payment of tuition is DUE ON THE 1ST OF EACH MONTH. Payment of tuition secures enrollment for your child in class. We do not mail statements; however, post tuition reminders around the studio and on the Company website. Other valuable information: _____ (please list specific payment terms here agreed upon staff and family member).

_____ I am required to have a credit card authorization form on file to process payments for tuition and all other fees associated with dance. Alternative option: post-dated checks and/or bank draft information. There are no exceptions to this rule.

_____ Competition season fees, recital fees and/or any other studio affiliated fees will *only* be allowed a 14-day grace period. Any student with unpaid competition season fees past 14 days will not be able to compete, participate in recitals and/or affiliated studio program.

_____ There is a 3-day grace period, to pay your tuition. On the 4th day, we will add a \$15 late fee and run your credit card on file unless we have received a "Drop" form or written notification dropping the child from class prior to the 1st of the month. NO EXCEPTIONS. If no card is on file, your child will **not** be permitted to classes after 14 days.

_____ TUITION REMAINS THE SAME EACH MONTH and does NOT deviate regardless of Holiday Closure or any other closures that the studio decides to take. Tuition is not pro-rated, refunded or credited for missed classes or holidays. Any student who misses a class may make-up classes in other non-performance classes that are comparable for their age/skill level.

_____ If your child is absent due to any reason: illness, vacation, or other activities, payment is STILL due by the 14th to continue to hold the spot in class for your child. There are NO REFUNDS for missed classes.

_____ If your child is no longer taking classes, a "drop" form must be completed or notification in writing is required before the start of the next month. Any outstanding fees on the account must be paid in full upon un-enrollment. Failure to turn in a "Drop" form will result in continued tuition charges and late fees, until we receive a completed form or letter. Withdrawal outside of the exit dates will result in a \$100 withdrawal fee.

_____ A \$25 return check/payment fee will be accessed on all insufficient fund checks/payments.

_____ If you are not available to pay in person, please either call the studio for payment over the phone, mail your payment (in time for your tuition to be delivered on or before your due date), or pay online to avoid late fees towards your tuition. Fees will be drafter on the 4th day of a missed payment.

_____ PHOTO RELEASE: By initialing here, I give permission for photographs and videos of my child in dance class or performances to be used in promotional material for iAM Dance Center of the Arts in both print and web publications.

I/WE HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the dance facility used by the participant, including its owners, managers, promoters, lessees of premises used to conduct the dance event or program, premises and event inspectors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions to engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the dance facility or events held at such facility and each of them, their directors, officers, agents, employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Release"...FROM ALL LIABILITY TO THE UNDERSIGNED, my/our personal representatives, assigns, executors, heirs and next to kin FOR ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES OR DAMAGES AND ANY CLAIMS OR DEMANDS THEREFORE ON ACCOUNT OF ANY INJURY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE DEATH OF THE PARTICIPANT OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THE EVENT(S) CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASE OR OTHERWISE.
5. I/WE HEREBY acknowledge that THE ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT(S) ARE VERY DANGEROUS and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. Each of THE UNDERSIGNED also expressly acknowledges that INJURIES RECEIVED MAY BE COMPOUNDED OR INCREASED BY NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS OR PROCEDURES OF THE RELEASEES.
6. EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the Province or State in which the event is conducted and that if any portion is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding continue in full legal force and effect.
7. On behalf of the participant and individually, the undersigned partner(s) and/or legal guardian(s) for the minor participant execute this Waiver and Release. If, despite this release, the participant makes a claim against any of the Releases, the parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s) will reimburse the Releases for any money, which they have paid to the participant, or on his behalf, and hold them harmless.

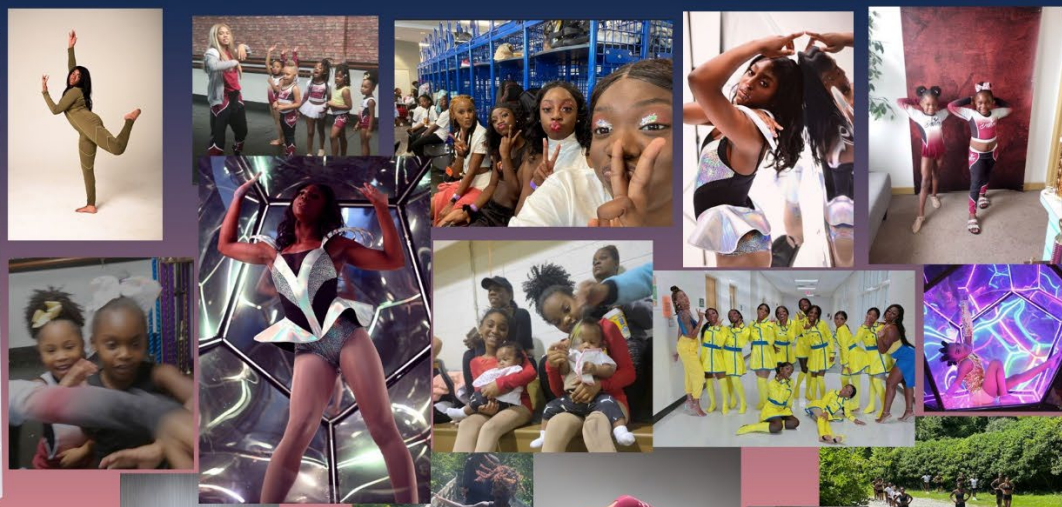
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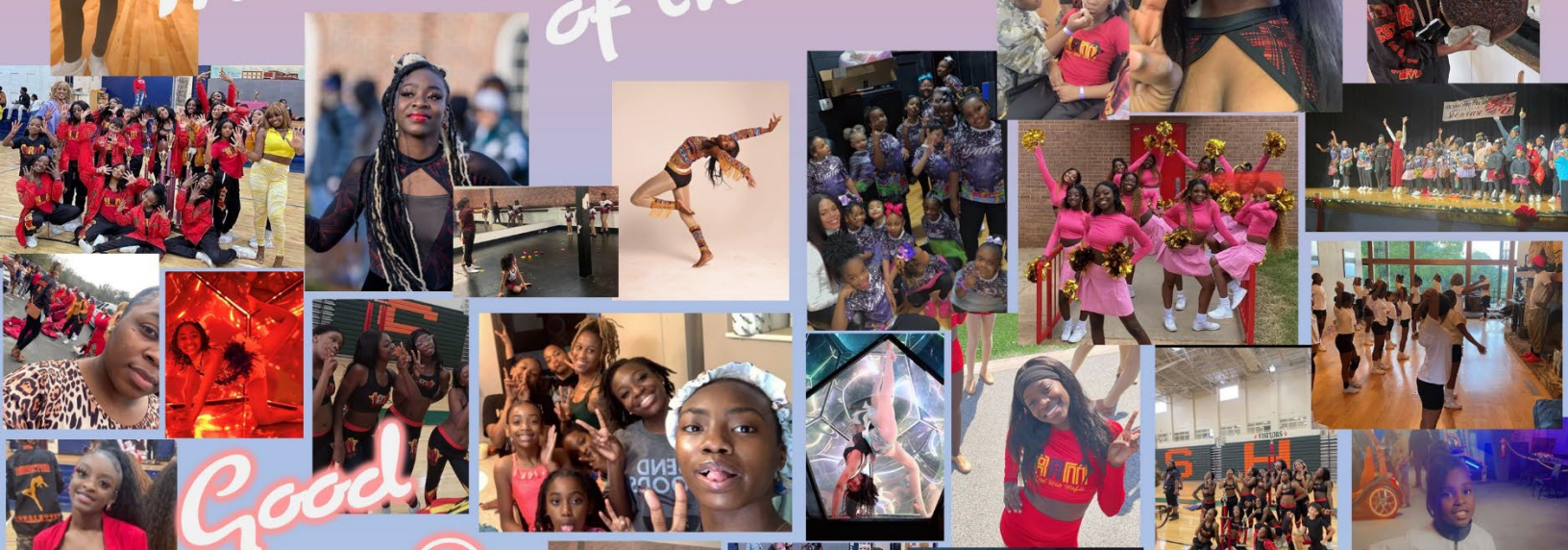
